Services DNIEC Provides to Students During Shelter-in-Place

Although DNIEC is currently closed to the public, we offer the following services to American Indian students:

- Tutoring and/or reading with students via phone/video calls on Face-Time/WeChat/Google Duo
- Delivering school work from local schools to DNIEC students
- Creating academic workbooks according to grade level upon request
- Deliver nutritious snacks to students upon request (Mondays-Thursdays)
- Offer smoking cessation kits (“quit-kits”) to DNIEC families upon request
- Correspond with school teachers/administrators as advocates for DNIEC students
